

June 10th: All Saints of Rus-Ukraine & North America

Tone 1 Tropar (Resurrection)

When the stone had been sealed by the Jews, / while the soldiers were guarding Your most pure body, / You rose on the third day, O Savior, granting life to the world. / The powers of heaven therefore cried to You, O Giver of Life: / “Glory to Your Resurrection, O Christ! / Glory to Your Kingdom! // Glory to Your dispensation, O Lover of mankind!”

Tone 8 Tropar (All Saints of Rus'-Ukraine)

As a beautiful fruit of salvation you have sown, O Lord / the land of Rus'-Ukraine offers You the Saints who have shone in her land. / By their intercession and through the Birth-Giver of God, / preserve the Church and our land // in profound peace, Greatly Merciful One.

Tone 8 Tropar (All Saints of North America)

As the bountiful harvest of Thy sowing of salvation, / the lands of North America offer to Thee, O Lord, all the saints who have / shone in them. / By their prayers keep the Church and our land in abiding peace // through the Theotokos, O most Merciful One!

Tone 4 Tropar (Parish Patron/Pokrova)

O Mother of God, sheltered by thy coming / we faithful people today keep feast in joy, / and looking at thy most pure image, / moved to the depths. Of our hearts, we say: / “Protect us with thy precious veil / and deliver us from every ill, / by entreating Christ, thy Son and our God, // to save our souls.

Tone 1 Kondak (Resurrection)

As God, You rose from the tomb in glory, / raising the world with Yourself. / Human nature praises You as God, for death has vanished. / Adam exults, O Master! / Eve rejoices, for she is freed from bondage and cries to You: // “You are the Giver of Resurrection to all, O Christ!”

Tone 3 Kondak (All Saints of Rus-Ukraine)

Today the choir of God pleasing saints from the land of Rus'-Ukraine / stands with us in church praying to God on our behalf; / with them the angels render glory / and all the Saints of Christ's Church celebrate: // for together they pray to the Eternal God for us.

Tone 3 Kondak (All Saints of North America)

Today the choir of Saints who were pleasing to God in the lands of North America / now stands before us in the Church and invisibly prays to God for us. / With them the Angels glorify Him, / and all the Saints of the Church of Christ keep festival with them; / and together they all pray for us to the Pre-eternal God.

Tone 2 Kondak (Parish Patron/Pokrova)

The Choirs of Saints and the Virgin / stand in church praying to God for us. / Angels and hierarchs bow in adoration, / Apostles and Prophets all rejoice / in thee, O Mother of God, // who for us prays to God Eternal.

Prokimen (Tone 1) Let Your mercy, O Lord, be upon us as we have set our hope on You!

v: Rejoice in the Lord, O You righteous; praise befits the just.

Prokimen (Tone 7) Precious in the sight of the Lord is the death of His saints.

Alleluia, Alleluia, Alleluia! (Tone 1, Psalm 17:47,50; Psalm 31:11)

v: God gives vengeance unto me, and subdues people under me.

v: He magnifies the salvation of the King and deals mercifully with David, His anointed, and his seed forever.
